Brief description:	<p>New building of an administration centre with a lounge on the roof, headquarters of the board of Wella AG, now Procter & Gamble</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- reinforced concrete building with 28 cm thick slender flat slabs spanning 10 m in some parts filigree steel construction- spatial load-bearing structure of multi-storey shear walls supported on one side on composite columns- shear walls hung back and centred via ceiling disks and embedded cores- complex bracing with special consideration of long-term deformations- underpinning of adjacent buildings by soil stabilisation using chemical injection- large underground visitors' parking covered with soil for planting of park trees
